BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday at 12:45 pm (except the first Sunday). Please call the Parish Office to set up an appointment to meet with a priest or deacon to complete the necessary paperwork. Pre-Jordan classes required for parents and optional for godparents, they are offered the second Wednesday of each month at 7:00 pm in the Parish Center unless otherwise noted in the bulletin. Letters of eligibility are due at the Parish Center before a date can be given for Baptism.



CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES SPOTLIGHT

As we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration this August, it's important to reflect on the mountaintop moments we sometimes experience, and how Jesus might be calling us to come down from the mountain to learn about uncomfortable truths, like the refugee crisis. It's easy to write-off the story of the Transfiguration. The idea of any mountaintop moment, even a less extreme one, may seem far removed from our daily lives. But perhaps we live on the mountaintop without even realizing it. We examine when, like Peter, we say, "it is good that we are here," in those situations where we are really comfortable, but perhaps no longer growing, being challenged or reaching out to others beyond our immediate community.

The Feast of the Transfiguration offers a chance for us to pause and reflect on the mountaintop moments we experience in the midst of our daily lives to examine why we want to stay on the mountain. Do we refuse to go beyond what is pleasant and comfortable? How might Jesus be calling us in our own particular situations to come down from the mountain? It looks different for each of us. Perhaps it involves spending more time volunteering at a local charity. Maybe it means learning about uncomfortable truths, like the refugee crisis or climate change.
