Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday at 12:45 pm (except the first Sunday). Please call the Parish Office to set up an appointment to meet with a priest or deacon to complete the necessary paperwork. #### This Is My Story: A Message from the Heart of Nancy Boak



My journey with Jesus in Eucharistic Adoration began when I was a young working mother raising two teenage daughters under very challenging circumstances. Of course, like so many of us it was when I hit a low point, a time of despair when I didn't know where or to whom to turn, that Jesus called me to come to him in Eucharistic Adoration.

Thankfully, even at 10 PM I knew where I could go to seek him out. The parish in the next town had Eucharistic Adoration 24/7. What blessing that would а become for me! I returned to the chapel time and again to confide in Him all my cares and concerns. I went from being overwhelmed and not sure how I would get it all done to someone who trusted in the Lord and relied on him with renewed confidence. In fact, things just seemed to fall into place. There were so many times, on my way home from work, when I would think "I really don't have the time to stop at the chapel". But I stopped in anyway, even if it was for only 5 or 10 minutes. Some how my time with Jesus centered the rest of my day. God is so good!

I have been the guardian coordinator for Eucharistic adoration at Saint Maria Goretti since 2010 when Fr. Peterson asked me to take up that function. It is a privilege for me to serve the Lord and SMG in this way. I invite you to come and join us in the chapel every Monday whether it be for 15 minutes or an hour. Seek His comfort and His counsel. He is waiting.
