

SVDP MONTHLY FOOD DRIVE

Next weekend, *February 12-13*, the Society of St. Vincent De Paul at St. Maria Goretti Parish will collect groceries for local charities. Please take a bag from the church vestibule and return it next weekend for a charitiy listed below.

Manna on Main Street operates a soup kitchen and food pantry that last year served nearly forty thousand meals. It needs bottled water, canned meats, canned fruit; canned tomatoes, tomato sauce, diced tomatoes; condiments, peanut butter, mixed nuts; canned beans, rice, spices; quinoa, barley, tissues; paper towels, baby wipes, laundry detergent; feminine pads, diapers sizes 4, 5, and 6, razors; deodorant, hair brushes, shampoo; hair conditioner, hand soap, shower gel; lip balm, vaseline, toothpaste; alcohol-free mouthwash, and cleaning products.

Hatfield Church of the Brethren operates a food pantry for residents of Hatfield Borough and Township. It needs cereal, tomato sauce, canned tomatoes; canned pineapple, canned Mandarin oranges, white rice; pasta (but not macaroni and cheese), dish detergent, laundry detergent; deodorant, toothpaste, personal care products; canned salmon, canned tuna, baby food; paper towels, and toilet paper.

<u>Shepherd's Shelf</u> provides groceries and other household items to approximately 110 needy households per month. It needs grape jelly, oatmeal canisters, boxed cookies; boxed crackers, diapers sizes 4 and 6, dry cat food; cat litter, tomato paste, apple sauce; pancake mix, pancake syrup, Chef Boyardee canned meals; gluten-free items, napkins, first aid items; feminine hygiene products, deodorant, body wash; unscented laundry detergent, dish detergent, and individual snack bags.

The Society cannot distribute opened packages, expired items, perishables, or religious articles. Cans and plastic containers are preferable to glass.
