It is now summertime and we hope you are enjoying it. But in few short weeks, it will be back to school time. Our parish encourages and supports Catholic education for our children. Last year, 127 of our children attended Catholic elementary schools — Mater Dei, Corpus Christi, St. Jude and St. Mary. We provided \$136,775 of financial support to those schools and, in addition, we provided over \$18,000 of need-based financial assistance to families with children attending these schools.
