

Connor O'Loughlin, the lead coordinator of emergency refugee services for Catholic Relief Services, spoke to USA Today about the situation: "For many, many people, those who are staying in Moldova, they want to be close to home and return when it's possible. WAYS TO GIVE & SUPPORT YOUR PARISH

Each week check this column for ideas to support your parish (some that will cost you nothing)

Wills and Bequests – As you think about how you want your estate distributed after your death, keep in mind that making a will is often inexpensive and easy with costs as low as \$100 for simple estates. Take care of your family first and help ensure that your intentions are carried out by making sure that you have a will and that it is current. Also, please consider including SMG Parish in your will, estate planning or insurance policy for a specific amount, a percent of your estate or a certain property as a legacy gift. We recommend that you talk with an estate planning attorney.

Periodic Review and Checklist

- ◆ Take a Few Moments—to pray and write down the names of loved ones, people and institutions, including SMG Parish, you hold dear.
- Review Your Current Will—if you have one to see if it is up to date. Most original wills can be old and not fit current circumstances. If you don't have a will make an appointment with an attorney.
- Select an Attorney—who specializes in estate, tax, trust work. Many attorneys specialize in many different area.
- Write a "Laundry List"—of personal items and who should receive them. Families are often in conflict about these items sometimes more than financial assets.
- Tally the Value of Assets—land, securities, real estate, insurance, IRA's, 401K's.
- Inform Loved Ones—of your plans and any change in plans. This can avoid family conflicts.
