





MANY HANDS MAKE LIGHT WORK

The Jordan Ministry is charged with making the white Baptismal robes for the newest members of our Faith Community. Once a year the committee gathers together to cut the material for the robes. Other members sew the robes at home.

The material and ribbon has been cut and packed up into 10 robe packages waiting to be sewn. It is simple straight stich sewing. Placing ribbon on the front, hemming all the sides, and sewing bias tape around the neck opening. No fancy stitching. You can work on them when your time allows.
