BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday at 12:45 pm (except the first Sunday). Please call the Parish Office to set up an appointment to meet with a priest or deacon to complete the necessary paperwork. Pre-Jordan classes required for parents and optional for godparents, they are offered the second Wednesday of each month at 7:00 pm in the Parish Center unless otherwise noted in the bulletin. Letters of eligibility are due at the Parish Center before a date can be given for Baptism.

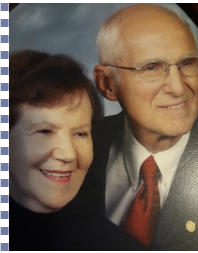
WEDDING ANNIVERSARY MASS

PARISHIONER SPOTLIGHT DICK & DOTTIE ECKARD



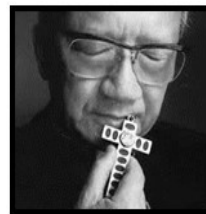

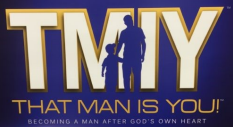
In preparation for the joy of the Easter season, please join your parish each Friday night during Lent for Stations of the Cross at 7pm.

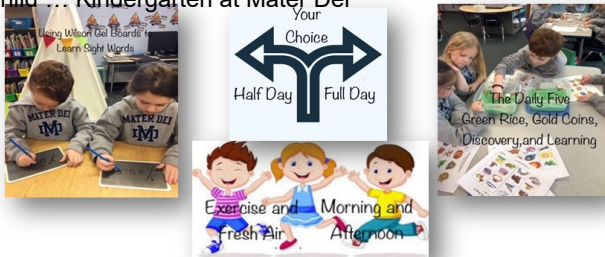
