



### **CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES**

Too many children in Sierra Leone still die of malaria. But a recent survey found a 50% decrease in malaria amongst children under 5 since 2013. What's the story behind these numbers? In 2019, CRS's \$154 million portfolio of 17 malaria projects reached 86 million people in 12 countries. Our programs focus on the people most vulnerable to malaria-related morbidity and mortality – children under 5 and pregnant women. We address the illness at household, community and facility levels. And we emphasize prevention, community and facility case management, procurement and supply chain management, along with advocacy at national, regional and international levels.

As a multi-sectoral organization, CRS can integrate malaria activities within other programs such as emergency response, food security and livelihoods, and immunization throughout malaria endemic countries. This allows CRS to quickly adapt and maintain its malaria outreach activities during disease outbreaks, such as Ebola and COVID-19. # CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD REGISTRATION

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) program is a Montessori based parish religious formation/ education program for children age 3 to 6 in LEVEL 1 and age 6 to 9 in LEVEL 2. This experience is foundational for a life-long relationship with God which is then lived out in the Church community. Children live the

central mysteries of our faith by working with and reflecting upon the materials that revolve around: the life of Christ, liturgical color, geography, the altar and the Eucharist, the Gospels of the birth, passion and resurrection of Jesus, Advent prophecies, parables including the Good Shepherd and the True Vine and

Both Levels are offered September through May.

<u>Level 1 (age 3-6)</u> sessions are held Sunday mornings and Monday late afternoons.

<u>Level 2 (ages 6 to 9)</u> sessions are held Wednesday mornings and late afternoon. CGS Level 1 attendance is required before Level 2.
