



CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES

During severe drought in Central America in 2018, farmers implementing CRS-supported soil practices harvested 41% more maize than with nor-

restoration practices harvested 41% more maize than with normal practices. By restoring their soil, they stored more rain to keep their crops growing, despite the drought.

In Nepal, farmers are growing cardamom on shady, steep land that previously did not support crops. With guidance from CRS's agricultural team, they can now produce this profitable spice, with the added environmental benefits of watershed protection and reducing erosion. ### WAYS TO GIVE & SUPPORT YOUR PARISH

Each week check this column for ideas to support your parish (some that will cost you nothing)

Gifts from Retirement Plans - Gifting assets accumulated through retirement plans can be a practical way to support SMG. Tax-free IRA rollover up to \$100,000 per year is now permitted by the IRS and counts toward your "Required Minimum Distribution" (RMD) if you are over age 70 1/2. Consider a charitable gift using all or a part of your RMD.

Do you Need to make an RMD for your IRA?

You may qualify for tax benefits when you give to charities directly from your IRA.

IRA free of federal income tax on your withdrawal - this year and in future years - if you meet the following criteria:

- 1. Are age 70 1/2 or older on the day of the gift.
- 2. Transfer up to \$100,000 directly from your IRA to one or more qualified charities such as St. Maris Goretti Parish. Note: This opportunity applies only to IRAs and not to other types of retirement plans.
- 3. Do not receive any goods or services in return for the rollover

You can benefit when you:

- 1. Wish to make a gift without using cash or other assets.
- 2. Do not need all or a portion of your IRA income.
- 3. Are paying too much in taxes and are looking to reduce your income
- 4. Want to increase your normal level of giving and IRA rollover gift does not count towards the 50% annual limitation on charitable gifts.

Making a gift from your IRA is easy! Please contact your tax preparer or financial advisor.
