



# **CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES**

Displacement brings instability and uncertainty, but for Aishatu Modibo Mohammed, her aspirations keep her focused on the big picture. 17-year-old Aishatu dreams of becoming a medical doctor, though she was not always sure if she'd achieve that goal. Five years ago, her family fled from their community when insurgents took over their hometown of Kanumburi in Borno State, Nigeria. Aishatu, her parents and younger siblings walked 25 miles through the wilderness to reach relative safety. They then boarded a vehicle and rode to what is now their host community in Gombe State.

Knowing his daughter's interest in medicine, Aishatu's father signed her up to volunteer for a program led by Catholic Relief Services that provides community-based malaria treatment to displaced persons. As a volunteer, Aishatu was trained as a Community Oriented Resource Person (CORP). In this role, she administers testing and treatment services. She does rapid diagnosis for symptomatic patients and administers artemisinin-based combination therapy doses to those who test positive. Since becoming a trained CORP, Aishatu estimates that she has tested over 350 people, 250 of whom tested positive for malaria, including family members.
