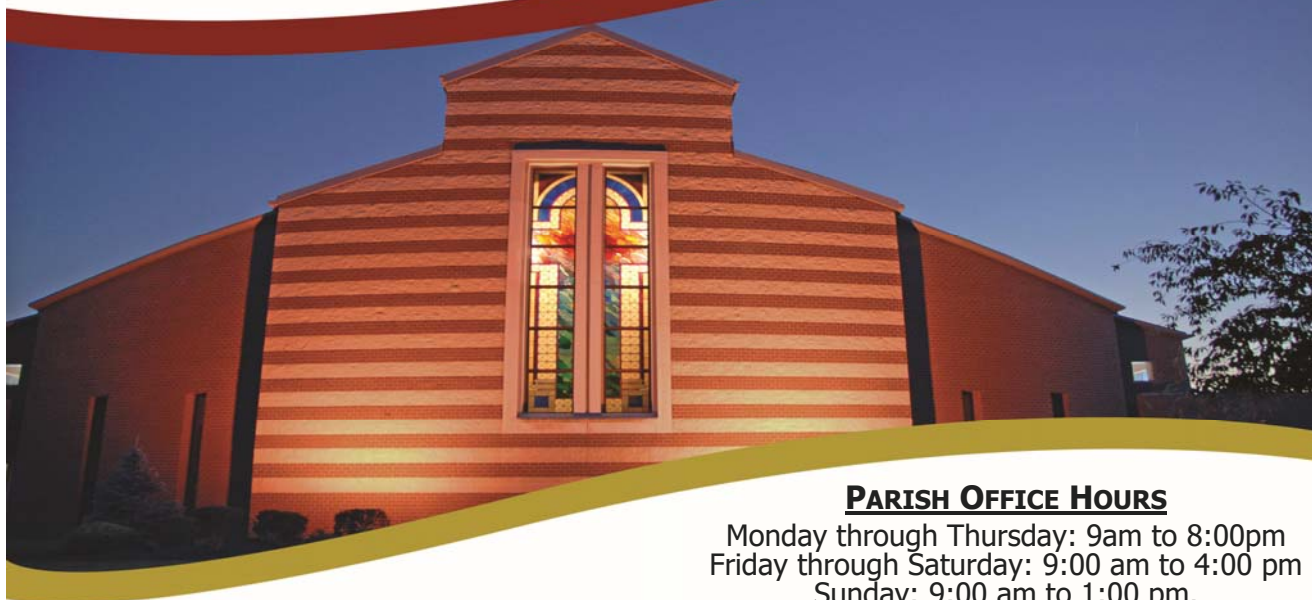

BAPTISM
