

Letters of eligibility are due at the Parish Center before a date can be given for Baptism.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least six months in advance. You must speak to a priest before making arrangements for a reception hall. Scheduling, rescheduling or cancellation MUST be done by a priest. Pre -Cana classes are required for all couples. SVDP MONTHLY FOOD DRIVE

The Society of St. Vincent De Paul at St. Maria Goretti Parish will collect groceries for local charities next weekend, February 11-12. Please take a bag from the Church vestibule and return it next weekend with groceries for one of the charities listed below.

Manna on Main Street operates a soup kitchen and food pantry that last year served nearly forty thousand meals. It needs diapers sizes 4, 5, and 6; baby wipes, toilet paper, paper towels; flour, sugar, baking powder; baking soda, pasta sauce, body wash; dried fruit, ketchup, mayonnaise; powdered milk, boxed milk (shelf stable), honey; applesauce, low-sugar cereals (Cheerios, Chex, etc.), cooking oil; dish soap, laundry soap, cleaning supplies; trash bags, plastic wrap, and foil.

Shepherd's Shelf is an emergency food cupboard. Its goal is to provide enough groceries and household items to feed households for three days. It serves households living in the Souderton Area School District, as well as Kulpsville, Lansdale, and Towamencin. It needs scalloped and/or mashed potatoes (boxed), condiments, coffee; napkins, paper towels, toilet paper; shower gel, shampoo, conditioner; deodorant, and other personal care items.

Hatfield Church of the Brethren operates a food pantry for residents of Hatfield Borough and Township. It needs cereal, tomato sauce, canned vegetables; canned pineapple, canned mandarin oranges, white rice; pasta, dish detergent; canned salmon, canned tuna, baby food; laundry detergent, paper towels, toilet paper; deodorant, toothpaste, and other personal care items.

The Society cannot distribute opened packages, expired items, perishables, or religious articles. Cans and plastic containers are preferable to glass.


