BAPTISM

Baptisms are limited to four children per Sunday. **Letters of eligibility are due at the Parish Center before a date can be given for Baptism.**

Scheduling, rescheduling or cancellation MUST be done by a priest. Pre-Cana classes are required for all couples. 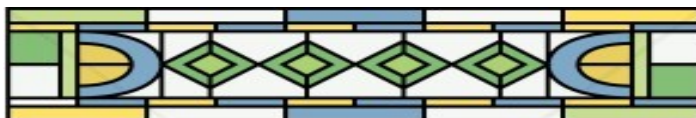

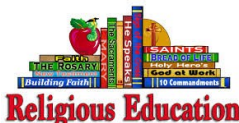
