



On February 6th, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake devastated large areas of central Turkey and northwest Syria. Later that day, the region experienced a second 7.7 magnitude quake. The death toll has surpassed 21.000

and continues to climb. The earthquake is the worst to strike Turkey this century. Across affected areas in both countries, apartment buildings and schools have been leveled. For Syrians, the damage took place in areas already devastated by years of war. In Turkey, the airports and the high roads of Anatolia are closed and most hospitals are unusable. Schools have been closed across the country.
