



# CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES



Like many people worldwide, Marie Josée Longo, a 62-year-old widow and mother of six, results, experienced the hardship of COVID-19 confinement at her home in Kinshasa, the capital

of the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Kinshasa is one of Africa's most populous cities, where millions of residents work 'cash-in-hand' jobs to support their families from one day to the next. With COVID-19 confinement measures in the city, many residents were unable to earn their regular living and provide for their families.

With support from the Center for Disaster Philanthropy and CRS private funds, CRS undertook multiple COVID-19 response activities in Kinshasa to meet the needs of families like Marie's. CRS provided 3,560 vulnerable households with direct food or cash assistance. Mobile money cash transfers targeted households with pronounced vulnerabilities to the virus, including those with immunocompromised members, or individuals living with pre-existing conditions. #### WAYS TO GIVE & SUPPORT YOUR PARISH Each week check this column for ideas to support your parish (some that will cost you nothing)

Savings Bonds—If you have savings bonds that have stopped earning interest and that you plan to redeem, you will owe income tax on the appreciation. Leaving them to loved ones means they will owe income tax and potentially estate taxes. In the end, your heirs will receive only a fraction of the value of the bonds in which you so carefully invested. You can leave your savings bonds to your favorite charity, such as SMG Parish, in your will. By doing so, your estate and your heirs will avoid taxes on the interest. To do this, you write a provision in your will that the savings bonds belong to the charitable organization when you die. Your estate administrator distributes the bonds to SMG for redemption. The bonds never count as part of your estate so there is no tax liability for your heirs. SMG reports the interest when it redeems the bonds, but because SMG is taxexempt there will be no tax due. See your financial planner for details.
