Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday at 12:45 pm (except the first Sunday). Please call the Parish Office to set up an appointment to meet with a priest or deacon to complete the necessary paperwork. Pre-Jordan classes required for parents and optional for godparents, they are offered the second Wednesday of each month at 7:00 pm in the Parish Center unless otherwise noted in the bulletin. Letters of eligibility are due at the Parish Center before a date can be given for Baptism.

ANNULMENTS





CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES SPOTLIGHT

Cyclone Fani, the worst cyclone to hit India, slammed into Eastern India's coast

on Friday, May 3, before traveling towards Bangladesh. As Cyclone Fani headed towards Eastern India and Bangladesh with sustained winds of 125 miles per hour, authorities evacuated over a million people ahead of time to prevent potential injury or loss of life.

More than 1.5 million people are displaced and in need of shelter, clean water and food. The cyclone destroyed land and crops, causing significant loss of families' livelihoods. Rohingya refugees, already displaced and living in massive settlements in Bangladesh, braced for the cyclone and the potential impacts of severe rains and flooding. 
