BAPTISM

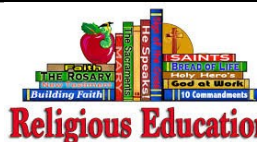

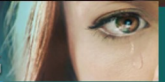

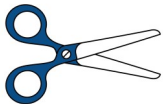
