



Dear Monica and Fr. Chung,

I write in grateful acknowledgement of the extremely generous donation of \$4,638.26 received from parishioners of St. Maria Goretti through the Poor Box Initiative. I so very much appreciate the attention given to our needs at the Parish of Our Lady of the Assumption in Vieux Fort, Saint Lucia. My sincere gratitude is expressed to Fr. John C. Nguyen and all of the parishioners who have contributed to our needs here. My heart is overwhelmed with appreciation and admiration for your support of our mission.

As mentioned to Fr. Chung some time ago, our parish is very large. Our main church is located in the town of Vieux Fort but the parish extends far beyond the town to other communities-three of which have chapels for worship: Grace, Pierrot and Dierre Morne. In Pierrot and Grace there are Catholic Schools. Funding for just about anything in the schools is difficult to obtain. Beyond the regular needs, it can be a challenge to expand, improve, update materials, provide extra services for children and attend to students with special needs.

Your very generous contribution, which converts to \$12,418.25 in Eastern Caribbean dollars, will help us to complete an extension on the Pierrot Primary School. We have been working for over 3 years to provide classroom space for special-needs children and the Principal's office. The current office will be converted into a library. The new structure is nearly complete; however, some finishing touches, as well as electrical installation and connection are still needed. With your help, the building will be ready for use in the near future. I am sure the staff and students join me in expressing deep gratitude for your assistance.

Being on a mission is a great joy and blessing. The ministry is very fulfilling, but there are always financial needs that are difficult to meet in a country where financial burdens are incumbent on many of our parishioners. Your kind assistance will go far in helping to ease the challenges we feel at times in our efforts to provide the best for our children.

Be assured of prayers and best wishes on behalf of myself and all who benefit from your participation in our mission. Know that we are very grateful and will remember you often and fondly in prayer.
