**CRS SPOTLIGHT**

Nearly 1 million people have fled Myanmar to Bangladesh. Many are staying in informal settlements because refugee settlements are at full capacity. Families arrive hungry, exhausted and depleted of any resources. The human needs, both emotional and physical, are immense. An estimated 50% of the refugees are women and children. The situation, which is even more complicated by the oncoming monsoon season, has already impacted food availability and prices, even for the local population.

CRS staff and refugees work together to prevent the risk of floods, landslides and outbreaks of water-borne diseases.
