BENEFITS ST. VINCENT dePAUL SOCIETY

Before leaving our church building each weekend, please consider stopping by one of our poor boxes located in the narthex with your contribution. For the months of **November and December, 2023**, all offerings from the poor box will be designated to **St. Vincent dePaul Society**. The SMG Conference of the Society was newly formed in 2007 and meets each Monday evening in the Parish Center to review the needs of individuals within our community. The Society works in collaboration with other organizations to provide person-to-person service, recognizing Christ in the face of those in need. The Society also supports the initiatives of the International Society, including clothing and food drives, as well as other special projects. This collection will provide much needed funding to fulfill our mission to serve the poor and needy. As quoted in the Society's motto... "No form of charity is foreign to the Society." ***If donating by check, please make payable to St. Maria Goretti. Thank you!***

2ND SUNDAY GROCERY COLLECTION



The Society of St. Vincent de Paul at St. Maria Goretti Parish will collect groceries for charity next weekend, **December 9-10**. Please take a bag from the church vestibule and return it next weekend with groceries for one of the charities indicated below.

The Lamb Foundation provides affordable housing and support services to senior citizens and adults with mental, physical, and developmental difficulties. It needs canned vegetables, canned fruit, canned salmon; canned chicken, Chef Boyardi meals, condiments; personal care items such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorant; shampoo, conditioner, toilet paper; paper towels, and household cleaners.

Keystone Opportunity Center operates an emergency food cupboard. Its goal is to provide groceries and household items to feed households for three days. It needs oatmeal (plain or flavored), boxed potatoes (scalloped or au gratin), broth; complete pancake mix, pancake syrup, Chef Boyardi meals; canned chicken, canned tuna, canned ham; salmon; spaghetti sauce, sugar in 1-lb. boxes or 5-lb. bags, canned fruit in juice; condiments, baked beans, laundry soap; toilet paper, paper towels; and gluten-free, sugar-free, and low salt products.

Manna on Main Street operates a food pantry and soup kitchen that serves more than forty thousand meals annually. It needs short pasta (macaroni, ziti, etc.), peanut butter, canned tuna, rice and pasta sides (Rice-a-Roni, Knorr); bean soups, cream soups, beef soups; boxed stuffing mix, apple sauce, granola bars; canned fruit in juice or syrup, raisins and other dried fruits, pasta sauce; baking soda, flour and sugar in household sizes, instant rice (white or brown); condiments, beef stew, baby wipes; paper towels, body wash, shampoo; conditioner, and soap.

The Society cannot distribute opened packages, expired items, perishables, or religious articles. Cans and plastic containers are preferable to glass.

CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES

Why was a delegation of Catholic leaders from Côte d'Ivoire in Washington, DC last month to talk with decision-makers about the growing violence in the central Sahel region? Because the people of Côte d'Ivoire are directly affected by the violence in at least 3 ways:

- 1) **Threat of terrorist attacks**: Côte d'Ivoire faces the threat of terrorist attacks from those who have expanded their operations from the Sahel to the coastal countries of West Africa, including Côte d'Ivoire. 2) **Influx of refugees and displaced people**: Côte d'Ivoire must deal with the influx of refugees and displaced people from the neighboring Sahel countries, especially Burkina Faso and Mali, who are fleeing from violence, poverty and hunger. 3) **Impact of climate change**: Côte d'Ivoire must cope with the impact of climate change and environmental degradation that affect the Sahel region and beyond.
