### ANNULMENTS

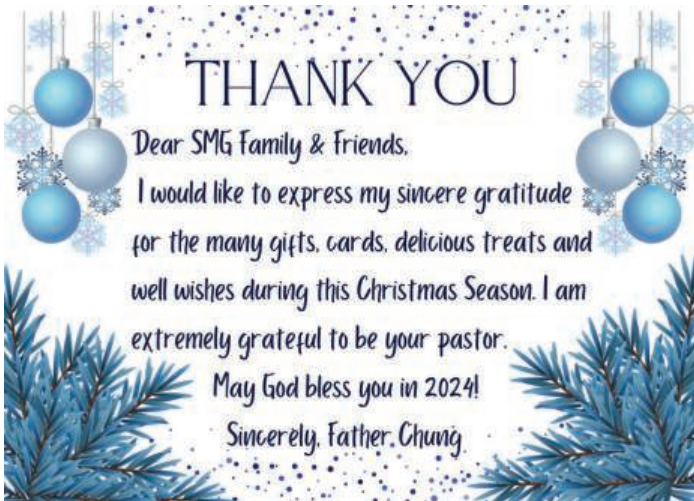

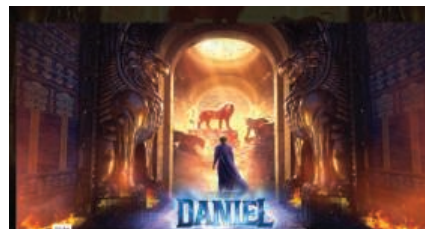
