BEGINNING JANUARY 2019, Community Health Choices (CHC) will provide Medicaid (Medical Assistance) coverage for people enrolled in both Medicare and Medicaid, enrolled in Medicaid waivers for physical disabilities, or live in a nursing home paid for by Medicaid. CHC is a managed care program. This means you will choose a CHC plan to manage all of your physical health care and long-term services and supports. **THIS IS ONLY FOR THOSE THAT ARE DUAL-ELIGIBLE FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE AND MEDICARE.** If you receive MEDICARE ONLY, THIS CHANGE DOES NOT AFFECT YOU.
