Eucharistic Guardians

A Guardian helps to ensure that someone is always keeping watch with Jesus and that He is never left alone by committing to spend thirty minutes or more in adoration each Monday. You share this commitment with a partner so that if an unforeseen scheduling conflict arises you can feel confident that another person is still keeping Jesus company at that time.

Promise to trust Him.

Tell Him you love Him.

Thank Him for the Sacraments.

Ask for forgiveness.

Ask Him to show you the next step.

Slowly recite the Beatitudes.

Say the Creed.
